COMMUNITY WORKSHOP FOR THE MARIN COUNTY OPEN SPACE DISTRICT ROAD AND TRAIL MANAGEMENT PLAN

SAN RAFAEL, CA: The Marin County Open Space District (District) will hold a community workshop for the District's new Road and Trail Management Plan and Environmental Impact Report (RTMP/EIR) on Saturday, March 26, 2011, at the Marin Health and Wellness Campus, Connections Center, 3240 Kerner Blvd., San Rafael (corner of Bellam and Kerner). The workshop begins promptly at 9:00 a.m. and concludes at 3:00 p.m., with a break for lunch. Attendees should plan on participating the full day.

The focus of the workshop will be on the types and levels of recreational use that can be accommodated on District preserves, while sustaining the desired resource and social conditions that fulfill the District's mission. Come prepared to learn about the history of open space in Marin County, and to contribute to the development of the range of appropriate and desired uses and resource conditions to be analyzed in the RTMP/EIR.
