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Marin County Transitions OB Care to Community Providers

San Rafael, CA - Starting April 1st, pregnant women insured by Medi-Cal began to receive their outpatient obstetrical care at Marin Community Clinics. Marin Community Clinics' new outpatient OB practice provides medical care, case management, mental health services and a diabetes and pregnancy program. The new OB practice will be located in the same building currently used by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) OB practice at the Health and Wellness Campus, 3260 Kerner Blvd., San Rafael.

The County will close its OB practice on June 24th. Existing patients will transfer to Marin Community Clinics and other community providers over the next 90 days. Pregnant patients will have access to hospital delivery services at Marin General Hospital through the services of a 24/7 physician-midwife delivery system managed by the Prima Medical Foundation.

The County will continue to offer clinics for HIV, Tuberculosis, Sexually Transmitted Diseases and Immunization at the Health and Wellness Campus.
