HAL BROWN PARK AT CREEKSIDE REOPENS

San Rafael, CA – Following extensive renovation, the Hal Brown Park at Creekside, which is located on Bon Air Road in Kentfield, officially reopens on Monday, February 14. Previously known as Creekside Park, the area now features an expanded playground with a climbing wall, a 17' climbing net, sand and water play areas, a turbo slide, swings, spinning bowls and Clapper Rail nests. An overlook has stunning views of Creekside Marsh and Mt. Tamalpais. Since the park is within walking distance of five schools, an amphitheater was enlarged to create opportunities for outdoor education. The park also has picnic areas, a spot for petanque, and a “health and meditation” area highlighting plants with medicinal attributes. All features within the park are accessible to individuals of all ages and abilities.

On Wednesday, February 2, students from Ross Valley Nursery School were treated to a preview of the new playground. The critics gave the park and the playground a big “thumbs up.” One student said, “I just want to live here!”

Following reopening, the park will be open during daylight hours.
