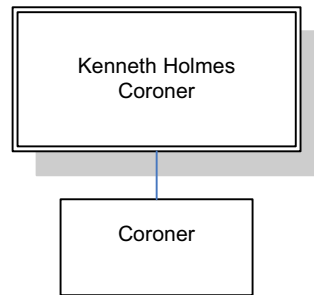

## Department Overview

The Coroner's Office is responsible for investigating the cause and manner of all sudden or unexpected deaths within the county, or natural deaths where the person has not been seen under the close care of a physician. The office is also responsible for identifying any unknown decedent and locating the next of kin and preserving all criminal and civil evidence and personal assets and estates.

Beginning January, 2011, the Office of Coroner will be reorganized into a new Sheriff-Coroner department as approved by the Board of Supervisors in 2010.
