Proposed Material: Maxforce Ant Bait Gel EPA Reg. No. 64248-21

Active Ingredient: Fipronil 0.001% Amount of Material Needed: Less than 2 oz., Placed in secure inaccessible bait stations. *g/v*

Location of Proposed Use: Marin County Juvenile Hall and Kitchen area.

Reason why Restricted:* Contains Fipronil, which has been determined to be a possible carcinogen.

Reason for Need: Ants have started to infiltrate into Administration areas, living quarters, and kitchen spaces. OMRI products and traps have been used. The ants have returned.

Options/Alternatives: General IPM practices to reduce ant populations (i.e. prevention of trash build-up, cleaning, and continued use of sticky traps and OMRI bait stations).

Plan to Preclude Future Use: Sealing points of access to prevent entry into the internal areas of the buildings (use of weather-stripping, caulking, etc.).

Time Period Needed: Desired application on 9/24/11 Friday after 5:30pm to reduce employee/user contact with material.
