Proposed Material: Wasp Freeze EPA Reg. Number: 499-362

Active Ingredient: Allethrin & Phenothrin

Amount of material needed: 17.5 oz. (one premeasured can)

Location of Proposed Use: Marin County Properties where wasp nests pose an immediate and significant threat to the public or staff, such as proximity to a path, picnic area or building where stings have or are likely to occur

Reason why Restricted: Wasp Freeze is on the Marin IPM use list; Exemption request is for a blanket reduction of the four day notice to a one day notice due to the risk of wasp stings so that the nests can be treated sooner to reduce risk.

Reason for Need: Active yellow jacket nests that pose an immediate hazard to employees and visitors

Options/Alternatives: Traps have been placed and are monitored.

Plan to Preclude Future Use: Continue to monitor and trap insects and queen wasps at appropriate time of the year.

Time Period Needed: Through 12-31-2011
