Active Ingredient: Allethrin & Phenothrin Amount of material needed: 34 oz.

Location of Proposed Use: McNear's Beach Park - 2 large paper wasp nests near the park walkway. High risk of wasp stings to employees and public

Reason why Restricted:\* Wasp Freeze product is on allowed use list.

Reason for Need: Exemption request is for next day application, with less than 4 days notice to the public

Options/Alternatives: Mint oil spray has not proved completely effective. The nest is in a prominent location near work areas and public access

Plan to Preclude Future Use: Locate nests when they are smaller and trap wasps when possible

Time Period Needed: one day for application
