San Rafael – Effective Monday, February 27, 2006 the winter storm Disaster Recovery Center will relocate into the Wells Fargo Bank located at 3 Tunstead Avenue, San Anselmo, CA 94960. The hours of operation for the Disaster Recovery Center are from 10:00 AM – 6:00 PM (M-F) and 10:00 AM – 2:00 PM on Saturday. They will be closed on Sunday.

The Disaster Recovery Center is continuing to provide ongoing financial assistance and support from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Small Business Administration (SBA) to victims of the recent New Years' Eve storms.

The deadline for registering for federal financial assistance is April 4, 2006. Disaster affected residents, including those with damage to or loss of vehicles, are encouraged to begin the FEMA application process by registering online at www.fema.gov or by calling 1-800-621-FEMA (3362). The hearing and speech impaired can call 1-800-462-7585 (TTY).

The toll-free telephone numbers will operate from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday – Saturday and will be closed on Sunday. Affected businesses can request disaster loans by contacting the U. S. Small Business Administration (SBA) toll-free at 1-800-659-2955. In addition to registering online or over the phone, residents and businesses can apply for assistance in person at the Disaster Recovery Center (DRC).
