

**PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY
BY THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Section 2.99 et seq., of the Marin County Code empowers the Assistant Director of Emergency Services, when assigned by the Director of Emergency Services, to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when said County is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the County Board of Supervisors is not in session, and;

WHEREAS, said Assistant Director of Emergency Services does hereby find:

That conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within said county, caused by Winter Storms; which began on the 10th day of April, 2006; and;

That these conditions are or are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of said County, and;

That the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin is not in session and cannot immediately be called into session;

WHEREAS, the Assistant Director of Emergency Services has made every reasonable effort to confer with the Director of Emergency Services and/or with one or more members of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that a copy of that proclamation of emergency be forwarded through the State Director of the Office of Emergency Services to the Governor of California with the request that he proclaim the County of Marin to be in a state of emergency;

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that Christopher A. Godley, Manager of Emergency Services, is designated as the local Hazard Mitigation Coordinator of the County of Marin for the purpose of assessing damage within said county and consulting with Federal/State survey teams about hazard mitigation actions.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that Farhad Mansourian, Director of Public Works, is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the County of Marin for the purpose of receipt, processing and coordination of all inquiries and requirements necessary to obtain available state and federal assistance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this proclamation be immediately forwarded to the Director of the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services.
