

## Pacific Railroad Centennial Exhibit



In celebration of the centennial of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad (1907 - 2007), the [Civic Center Library](#) is hosting an exhibit on the railroads which ran through Marin County. Included is a pictorial timeline of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad created by the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Society; historic photographs and ephemera from the Anne T. Kent California Room collection; and scale models of ferryboats and railroad cars from the collections of the Belvedere-Tiburon Landmark Society and the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Society. The exhibit will run from March 1 through May 31.
