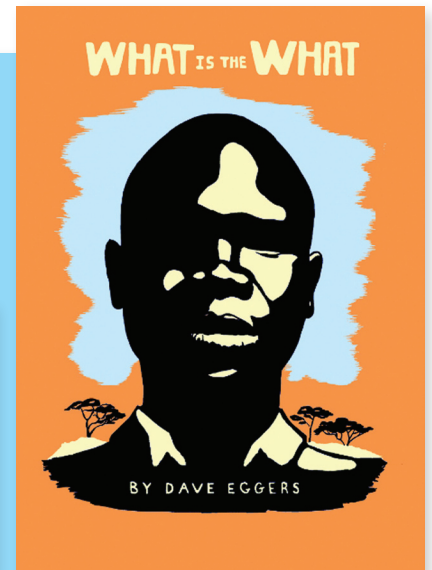

The 2009 selection for One Book One Marin is Dave Eggers's highly-acclaimed novel *What is the What: The Autobiography of Valentino Achak Deng*. This story of the lost boys of the Sudan is an inspired choice. Deng was chased from his village at age seven and forced to trek across Africa under the most harrowing circumstances. The San Francisco Chronicle calls the book "strange, beautiful and unforgettable."

Francine Prose, writing in the N.Y. Times Book Review, called it "An extraordinary work of witness, and of art." *What is the What* was a finalist for the National Book Critics Circle Award.

After the publication of *What Is the What*, Valentino Achak Deng and Dave Eggers established the Valentino Achak Deng Foundation, a non-profit organization working to advance education in Southern Sudan.

The Foundation is currently building an 11-structure educational complex in Valentino's hometown of Marial Bai, including the first secondary school in the region, a library, a teacher-training college, a community center, and sports facilities.
