

NEW DISABILITY ACCOMMODATIONS SERVICE AVAILABLE

The Disability Access Program is now able to assist individual departments and programs in securing auxiliary aids and services for your public meetings. As you know, all announcements of county sponsored public meetings require inclusion of a statement offering to provide accommodations upon request. If you chose, you may now put the dedicated telephone number and dedicated e-mail address below as the point of contact for such requests and Disability Access Program staff will assist in coordinating provision of needed accommodations. These could include American Sign Language interpreters, readers, note takers, assistive listening devices and other auxiliary aids and services. Please be sure to conduct all meetings at accessible sites. A list of accessible sites is available from the Disability Access Program.

If you use this service, you must be sure to send a copy of your meeting notice to the Disability Access Program e-mail address.
