SUBJECT: DIVISION OF COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES: AGREEMENT WITH THE CENTER FOR RESTORATIVE PRACTICE FOR FY 09/10 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$71,440.

Dear Supervisors:

RECOMMENDATION: Authorize President to execute FY 2009/2010 agreement with the Center for Restorative Practice (CFRP) in an amount not to exceed \$71,440.

SUMMARY: Contractor assists children with serious emotional disturbance and their families in developing and implementing individualized service plans that are reflective of each family's expressed needs.

CONTRACTOR PERFORMANCE: CFRP submits an annual report to CMHS with a list of goals set, signs of success by which those goals are measured and goal attainment status for the clients served during the contract year. In FY 08/09, CFRP served 24 family teams with 25 goals. 52% of goals were completed or partially completed (objective 66%) and there was a 10% reduction in the number of identified incidents that led families to seek mental health services (objective 10%).

COMMUNITY BENEFIT: This program provides the family with a structured and supportive process for developing, monitoring and refining family-centered, strengths-based service plans. The goal is to increase the active participation of families in the child's treatment and reduce the number of repeated incidents of the issues.

FISCAL IMPACT: The funds for this action are included in Fund Center 1000043000 for FY 2009/2010. The contract allows for cancellation, with thirty days' notice, should the County not be able to continue to fund. There is no additional net County cost associated with this request.
